**PHS Lesson 3 – Honoring God & Family**

Read this chapter and on a separate sheet of paper, please answer the following questions. You must answer in complete sentences in paragraph form.

1. When God gave us the Ten Commandments, He intended to strengthen our relationship with Him. Because we are descendants from His chosen people, we observe and value these Commandments. Each Commandment is concerned with a particular human behavior. The first three Commandments are concerned with how we respect and love God. With this thought in mind, define the following terms:
  - idolatry
  - superstition
  - sacrilege
  - simony
  - atheism
2. We live in a world where we are constantly receiving advertising messages. In what way does this tempt people to worship false gods?
3. God has established a special relationship with us. Scripture quotes Him in telling us “It was not you who chose Me, but I who chose you!” Because of His love and concern for us, we must respectfully obey Him. How does using His name in circumstances other than prayer and worship violate this relationship?
4. The Third Commandment tells us very clearly to set aside the Sabbath Day to honor and worship God. In our busy world, this Commandment is sometimes difficult to observe. What adjustments do you and your family make to keep this Commandment?
5. The Fourth Commandment is the “bridge” between the first three Commandments and the last six. The special attitudes the Church teaches addresses children. Parents are owed respect, gratitude, obedience and assistance. Give an example of how young people today can observe this commandment by obeying each of these attitudes.
6. Parents bear a responsibility to provide for the spiritual, emotional and physical needs of their children. In your own words, give a description of your understanding of this responsibility. How do others in “parental” roles also provide for the children in their care?
