


### MESSAGE FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR



My Dear Parish Family, As we celebrate this Second Sunday of Advent, I hope and pray that you are able to balance the busyness of the preparation for Christmas with the call of Advent to prepare by way of prayer, reflection and repentance. It is difficult to maintain a proper spirit of Advent preparation in the midst of Christmas music on the radio, shopping, writing cards and parties and more. I urge you to remain as focused as possible. Please consider coming to our parish Penance Service this Tuesday, December 10, at 7:00 pm in Church. We will have about

eighteen priests here to celebrate the Sacrament of Penance for us that night. This is a great way to celebrate Advent!

As you may or may not be aware, I am approaching the conclusion of my six year term as your Pastor on February 1, 2020. What does this mean? First, it means that the Diocese of Buffalo will be conducting an evaluation of my ministry at St. Greg's. This evaluation is standard procedure for every priest as he concludes his term as a pastor or as a parochial vicar. At this point twenty parishioners have received evaluation forms to be completed and mailed directly to the Priest Personnel office. The parishioners who received the evaluation forms were selected by our parish trustees per the Diocesan guideline. I thank our parish trustees, Christie Thein and Tom Vacanti, for all of their work on this process and for all they do weekly for us at St. Greg's. I also thank all those who have taken on the responsibility of participating in this important evaluation process for the Diocese.

To my knowledge, the evaluation forms are due by the middle of the month of December. It is also my understanding that a member of the Priest's Personnel Board will read and assess all of the evaluations and formulate a report which will be presented to Bishop Malone and reviewed with me. Having outlined the process, the question may still remain: "What does this mean?" A pastor who completes his first term of six years is eligible for a second, six

year term as pastor of the same parish. Although pastors are often renewed for another term, it is not guaranteed. At this point in the process I cannot give you a clear or firm answer to the question. I do not know our Bishop's thoughts on my remaining at St. Greg's or pursuing another ministry, nor do I know the recommendations from members of the Priest Personnel Board. Although I am very happy and honored to continue my ministry at St. Gregory's, I am also looking forward to receiving the evaluation report from our parishioners in order to make an informed decision on my part as to what is best for St. Gregory's and for me. I am sharing this information with you in an effort to remain transparent regarding the administration of our parish family. This is a very standard process and I will keep you informed as we progress through it. It is also a natural time for me to personally review and assess my overall ministry and especially as pastor of St. Greg's. St. Gregory's has changed over the last six years. Change is difficult, but change is also good. On the positive side, I believe we have accomplished many wonderful things. Among the most visible accomplishments is the renovation of our Church as well as the development of a five year plan for capital maintenance. We are in the process of accomplishing the replacement of all roofs on all of our parish buildings. These projects are all under the direction of our Buildings and Grounds Committee which, I re-established shortly after arriving at St. Greg's. I thank all of the members of this committee for their awesome hard work.

On the spiritual side, I believe that we are strong in our Faith. Our youth ministry has grown and developed exponentially. We now have a vibrant youth ministry for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Graders as well as 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Graders, in addition to our Life Teen Program for our High School teens. We are blessed to have expanded our youth ministry program to include positions for three full time youth ministers. This is unparalleled in our Diocese and beyond. We have also established a Young Adult Ministry that continues to grow in number and strength.

### (Pastor's Article Continued)

They just completed another awesome weekend retreat with over 40 young adults participating. Although some ministries have changed and a few have ended during the last six years, the majority of our eighty-plus ministries are alive and vibrant.

Over these six years we have seen a change in our parish staff. Most notably, we are the only parish in the Diocese to have a full time Director of Evangelization. We are also blessed to have two full time music ministers to give direction to our worship.

As I look to the present moment and our needs, I see a few areas to address. First, is the enrollment in our School and Family Faith Formation programs, as numbers have dropped. On one hand, there are simply fewer children in Western New York. This was brought to our attention on the first day of school when The Buffalo News ran an article questioning where all of the kids are on the first day of school. The article statistically outlined the reality that there are simply fewer children in Western New York. That information, along with the fact that we see an increasing number of younger families that do not wish to live a life of faith within the context of "organized religion," poses a challenge for us. Next, we must continue to live through the current crisis of the Church regarding the sexual abuse of minors. I have every confidence that healing will take place for victims; some parishioners who have left the active practice of faith will return and the Diocese will move forward with renewed strength and direction. This will, of course, take time to accomplish. We have all been concerned over a decline in Sunday Mass participation and we need to focus on correcting this trend. Of course there are many reasons for a decline in Church attendance including the scandal, the passing away of long-standing parishioners, people moving out of Western New York, as well as a general decline in people "joining" a church. I sadly state that some have left because of Church doctrine, and some have left simply because of differences with me or other members of the pastoral staff. On the positive side, many have also come forward to join St. Gregory's parish to the point that we have overall netted a few-hundred-family increase in our census.

For now, please pray for the evaluation process. Pray especially for those who are filling out my evaluation forms. Pray for our Bishop and the Priest Personnel Board members as they do their research and make decisions. Please pray for our whole parish family. Finally, I wish to thank you, our parish family, for all that you continually do to live your Faith and to support the work of the Church.

May God bless you, our Mother Mary watch over you and St. Gregory the Great intercede for you, always.






