From the Desk of Parish Nurse:

Mid summer greetings from Health Ministry. Actually, "The Fair" has been in full swing the past week, so we may well be tetering close to fall. Most people I've talked with tell me this has been the hottest and fastest summer they can remember in a long time, but are looking forward to fall, settling back into their rountines, kids back to school etc...As for me my comfort number is ahh..78°. I don't tolerate 90°well at all.

While Fr. Leon is on sabbatical, he asked staff members to share about their ministry in his column. Health Ministry, I believe, is the smallest ministry on campus, both in hours and people on staff (1 person, 6-10 hrs. per week). Located in the Ministry Center, second floor, with a mobile office at any Tim Hortons, Wegmans, our Café and from time to time the parking lot.

Our Parish Health Ministry roots itself in Christ's ministry by treating the "whole" person, physical, emotional and spiritual, through resources that support getting healthy, staying healthy and dealing with illness by integrating care of mind, body and spirit. Focusing on providing parish-wide health education opportunities through speakers and seminars, and providing one-on-one health related information for parishioners who may need assistance regarding health issues. Also can provide support and access to community health resources when a parishioner is caring for a loved one or friend who is living with a chronic illness and is alone or far away from family, or if they need assistance accessing health services for in-home care or multilevel facility care.

Through a wonderful group of parishioner volunteers we host a RESPITE for memory care the first Saturday of each month in the Gathering Rooms from 11:00am-2:00pm. We also offer Blood Pressure screening various times through the year and Flu Shot Clinic every fall.

This is a beautiful service ministry that allows me the opportunity to encounter, engage and equip our parishioners and their families with resources as a disciple of Christ through me for them.

I'm thankful for the many areas of our Parish this ministry takes me to. May you always dwell in the light of our Lord and be nourished through his Holy Eucharist and Prescious Blood.
