CLASSROOM RULES

- Respect the catechist and other students by BEING ON TIME for your session and Christian courtesy to all. HATS AND COATS OFF DURING CLASS TIME.
- Respect the property that is given for your use. Do not open desks or touch lockers. NO GUM, CANDY OR ANY OTHER FOOD IS ALLOWED INTO THE BUILDING.
- Any electronic devices, phones, ipads, etc cannot be used during class time and will be taken away and brought to the Faith Formation Office to be picked up after class.
- To avoid accidents and other serious problems — running, shoving, pushing and snowballs are prohibited at all times!
- 5) Any student who is tardy (arrives after the times listed) MUST FIRST REPORT TO THE OFFICE FOR A LATE SLIP before going to the classroom.
- 6) Students are not allowed anywhere in the building without adult supervision.
- 7) Students cannot enter a classroom, gym or cafeteria without a catechist or a designated adult present.
- Students who take part in disrupting their session by having a lack of respect for their catechist and/or peers will receive a <u>VERBAL</u> <u>WARNING FROM THEIR CATECHIST</u>. If the disruption occurs again, the Three Strikes Policy will be followed. (Please see right column.)

DRESS CODE

Students must come to class appropriately dressed.

NO bare midriffs, halter tops, or suggestive clothes are allowed in class*.

a.) **Shorts and skirts:** The length must be longer than fingertips when standing naturally with arms to the side.

b.) Necklines: No visible cleavage.

c.) **Pants**: Pants should be worn at the waistline. Sagging is not acceptable. Underwear should remain "down under" and should not be visible.

*Parents will be called to bring appropriate attire or to pick up student <u>immediately</u> if this is not followed.

THREE STRIKES POLICY

1st OFFENSE

1. Report to the office and parent will be called to sign classroom rules with student.

2nd OFFENSE

2. Report to the office and call parents for an immediate ride home.

3rd OFFENSE

3. Director will call parent and student will be removed from the Family Faith
