#### From The Desk of the Pastor

My dear parish family, as we celebrate Father's Day, please know that we ask God's blessing upon all of our Fathers, Grandfathers and Godfathers. Please know how important you are, my brothers. God has entrusted you with the role of St. Joseph in the world today, meaning to care for, love, protect and spiritually lead your family. This is an awesome task in this complicated world. It is also a tremendous blessing. My brothers, please look to the prayerful, simple and attentive life of St. Joseph to model your own role as Father. May God bless you this Father's Day. In addition to all of the Masses being offered in Church for the Father's Day Novena, I will also be offering an additional Mass each day for the Novena intentions just as I did for the Mother's Day Novena. Happy Father's Day!

This Sunday, after the 8:00 am Mass, we will be dedicating the new plaque explaining the meaning of Our Lady of Lourdes. This plaque will be dedicated in Memory of Mrs. Rose Hoelscher, who belonged to St. Gregory the Great parish for many decades. Rose passed away on December 23, 2017. During her life here at St. Gregory the Great, she was devoted to our Blessed Mother in an exemplary way. She began the traveling statue of Mary and personally delivered and picked up the statue weekly from people's homes in addition to coordinating the scheduling of the ministry. She was a strong advocate for our Grotto and a faithful member of the Ladies of the Lord. Rose was a participant in almost every ministry at St. Greg's. Rose's family will be present at the 8:00 am Mass and afterwards we will proceed to the Grotto for the dedication and blessing. All are welcome to join us in prayer. An additional plaque bearing Rose's name will soon be installed.

Also, there will be a change coming up at St. Greg's regarding seating and the distribution of Communion. I have received several complaints regarding the way we handle taking Communion to those who may be disabled or handicapped and not able to proceed in a line to receive Communion at Mass. Virtually every parish I have served in and been privileged to visit, has a designated handicapped section. St. Greg's also has a designated section in the back of the church. It has developed over time that many do not wish to sit there and Eucharistic ministers and/or priests and deacons walk to many different parts of the church to distribute Communion to those who cannot easily walk. We are very grateful to do this, but the time has come to limit this to designated areas. Beginning next weekend, June 30 and July 1 the first row on both sides of the center aisle will be designated as handicapped rows and the priest and/or deacon distributing communion in front of the church in the center aisle will come to all those in those 2 benches to distribute the Eucharist. Similarly, the last row of the center aisle will also be designated for the handicapped and the Eucharistic Minister designated for the balcony will bring the Eucharist to those in that row.

I humbly ask those in need of Communion being brought to them to sit in one of these three designated rows to allow for an orderly and timely period of Communion during the Mass. Our Ushers will be able to direct you to the proper row. Thank you for your cooperation with this matter.

As we look to the refurbishment of our pews, as I have mentioned before, it appears that we will be replacing our benches and not simply refinishing them. It will be less expensive to replace them and it will also allow for us to reconfigure the church to include a designated section for those with handicaps. We will keep you informed as we progress with these plans. (continued on pg. 2)

I would also like to announce and thank Mr. Gregory Bruno who has agreed to join our Parish's Finance Council. He has served on the council in past years and I am grateful for his enthusiastic

yes to serve again.

Finally, I'd like to say a word about my upcoming sabbatical. I have been asked by many what my plans are during my sabbatical and I published them in the May 8 Bulletin. Last weekend in particular many were asking me after Masses what I was going to be doing and I do apologize to many as time simply did not allow me to answer your question. I appreciate your interest, concern and well wishes and I do apologize if I was short in my responses as I needed to either prepare for the next Mass or attend to other matters at that moment. With that in mind I will restate my sabbatical plans: My sabbatical is planned from July 1, 2018 to December 1, 2018. During this entire time I remain in fact the Pastor of St. Gregory the Great Parish and return as Pastor to continue my term. I am most thankful to Father Tom Mahoney who will be the Administrator in my absence and working closely with our new priest, Father Paul Cygan, and Msgr.Thomas Maloney.

The first week of my sabbatical I intend to sleep and catch up on some needed rest. I will be attending a retreat for Priests in West Virginia on the Identity of the Priest as Understood in the New Testament. This will be given by Dr. Scott Hahn from Franciscan University. I will attend a Scripture conference and an Apologetics conference at Franciscan University and also intend to take a couple courses from Franciscan in the fall term.

Finally, I hope to complete writing a book and do some travel, most notably to Italy, and to spend some time in the Adirondack Mountains and at the Trappist Monastery in Piffard, NY. While in Rome, I plan to celebrate Mass at St. Peter's Basilica and hopefully will be graced enough to preside at Mass above St. John Paul II's tomb. I am also thankful to Cardinal Dolan and to our Holy Father for inviting me to be elevated to the rank of Commander in the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem, Eastern Lieutenancy. The Knights of the Holy Sepulchre is a Roman Catholic order of knighthood under the protection of the Holy See. The Pope is the sovereign of the Order which was established circa 1099. This will take me to New York City for an investiture at St. Patrick's Cathedral by Cardinal Dolan. It is an ambitious agenda and if I accomplish all of this I will probably need a vacation from my sabbatical! Please know that I will be praying for my St. Greg's family daily especially as I celebrate daily Mass. Please pray for me! May God bless you, our Mother Mary watch over you and St. Gregory the Great intercede for you, always.
