My Dear Parish Family,

As we celebrate this weekend we are looking forward to the great celebration of Pentecost next Sunday. Pentecost officially ends the season of Easter and is the perfect time for us to pray to open our own mind and heart to unpack the graces and power of the Holy Spirit in our lives. I fear that often we treat the gifts of the Holy Spirit as we do many gifts we may receive at Christmas or on our Birthday: "Oh, this is nice," and it gets shelved in our closet or put into a drawer or the basement or attic. Fortunately the gifts that get shelved or stored away still exist and can be pulled out and used at any time we may see that we actually need them. If there are any gifts of the Spirit that you have shelved or put away, maybe gifts that you do not understand, this week may be the week to pull them out and use them. The gifts of the Spirit include: wisdom, knowledge, counsel, fortitude, understanding, piety and fear of the Lord. Do you know spiritually what these gifts mean for your faith? How effectively are you using these gifts? This week maybe pick one to really study the meaning of and invite into your mind, heart and soul in a deeper way. Ask the Holy Spirit this week, and especially on Pentecost, to give you His power!

BISHOP MALONE TO HOST 2019 LISTENING SESSIONS

Bishop Richard Malone, in conjunction with the Presbyteral Council, Vicars Forane, and the Movement to Restore Trust, will host a series of Listening Sessions across the Diocese of Buffalo during the next few months. The Sessions will include Bishop Malone praying with the faithful, hearing their thoughts and comments, inviting discussion, and offering summary remarks regarding the mission of the Diocese and its parishes, schools, and other organizations.

The Listening Sessions are designed for the Bishop to hear the concerns of the engaged parishioners and for them to offer recommendations for future initiatives regarding pastoral care, spiritual care and ministry. Recognizing the importance of the input and empowerment of the laity working in collaboration with pastors, these listening sessions are an opportunity to create constructive partnerships, receive feedback, and formulate next steps to address the effects of the clergy sexual abuse crisis and other matters of concern.





RESPECT LIFE

USCCB Statement on the Equality Act:

Five chairmen of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops have expressed strong opposition to the U.S. House of Representatives' passage of the Equality Act (H.R. 5) on May 17. The Act would add the new terms "sexual orientation" and "gender identity," as well as "pregnancy [...] or a related medical condition," to the definition of "sex" in federal civil rights laws; expand the types of entities covered under those laws; and exempt itself from the Religious Freedom Restoration Act of 1993.

The statement was issued by Archbishop Joseph F. Naumann, chairman, Committee on Pro-Life Activities and the chairmen of the Domestic Justice and Human Development, Catholic Education, Religious Liberty, and Defense of Marriage committees.

"Our Faith calls us to uphold every individual's dignity and rights against unjust discrimination - including in employment, housing, and services - regardless of characteristics or background. Rather than offering meaningful protections for individuals, the Equality Act would impose sweeping new norms that negatively impact the unborn, health care, charitable services, schools, personal privacy, athletics, free speech, religious liberties, and parental rights. The Act's unsound definitions of 'sex' and 'gender identity' would erase women's distinct, hard-won recognition in federal laws. Its sex-based nondiscrimination terms would end women's shelters and many single-sex schools. It would close faith-based foster care and adoption agencies that honor children's rights to a mother and father. The bill would even act as an abortion mandate. We must pursue justice and equality for anyone denied it; but this is a regrettable approach. We are gravely disappointed with the Act's passage in the U.S. House." (usccb.org)
