

## STATE OF THE YOUTH ADDRESS

Greetings to you all from your Youth & Young Adult Ministry here at St. Greg's. I have started my eighth year here at the Parish and wanted to share how the ministry is coming along. The state of the youth is strong!

Our mission, "To lead people to Christ with authentic holiness and radical hospitality," is more relevant today than ever. With so much news and distraction from who we are as a Church, it has been imperative to create a culture where people come home to Jesus. We take this mindset into Youth & Young Adult Ministry by developing a faithful and fearless community that inspires word of mouth invitation. While challenges exist in the Church and world today, we are not embarrassed to be Catholic and work to make sure the beauty of the Faith shines bright. Saints are created and called in times like this.

Nicole and the Middle School Core Teams have been working hard on developing the youngest of our "tweens" from Grade 5 up through Grade 8. Introducing the new age group of 5th grade has proven to be challenging yet fruitful. Ignite (grades 5-6) and Edge (grades 7-8) have been growing vibrantly. The kids who came back from Camp Hidden Lake were passionately on fire for Christ. This year is going to continue to thrive and grow beyond where we've been with middle school, the most awkward but energetic years for our youth.

Richard and company have been working hard on our High-School front by growing Life Teen and expanding new offerings such as SWAT, a deeper night for teens, as well as Empowered in Christ, a girls community to develop Faith and virtue. I heard powerful witnesses from this summer's trip to Covecrest from teens who tore down obstacles that were in the way to a relationship with Christ. This past week, Richard and I teamed up to provide a retreat experience for our graduated seniors to help them transition to the next phase of life as adults. In addition, the music team has been leading excellent worship for our experiences and teaching the next generation of musicians what it means to lead with talent and prayer.

Young Adult Ministry has been growing beyond where I thought we would be now. Our team has been focused on building relationships and great nights with Amped. We are now attracting 40-50 participants an event. We've had two powerful retreats this year, Brave and Flourish, which has proven to be fertile ground in evangelization. Brave II is coming this November and looks to be our strongest event yet. We're already looking forward to our third run of Exodus 90, developing Faith and discipline in men to be better for the Lord and the world. For our ladies, a new Women's Community is taking root and promises a fresh take on the faithful, feminine heart. (continued to page 2)

# **CHILDRENS ENVELOPES**



Many years ago Msgr. Wright began a giving program for our Parish children. He believed it was important to instill in our young parishioners, the future of our Faith, with the importance of giving to their parish and their community. Since its inception, each year every child in our School and Family Faith Formation program receive contributions envelopes with the intent that half of what is given in these envelopes would stay in our Parish and half would go to charities directly helping children. Every week a small stack of the children's envelopes are placed in the collection basket with their parents' contributions. The chil-

dren's are counted and tallied separately. Over the years the children of St. Gregory the Great Parish have donated over \$22,000 to charities including Children's Hospital, Roswell Park Cancer Institute, Variety Club of Buffalo, Camp Good Days and Special Times, Catholic Charities, Leukemia & Lymphoma Society, Sisters Hospital, CF Foundation, Miracle League of Grand Island and WNY, and St. Jude's Research Hospital.

As the new school year begins and your children bring home their envelopes for the new year, please discuss with them their significance and how every little bit helps their Parish and their community.



# ASSISTED SUI-CIDE LEGALIZED IN NJ: As of August 1,

"The Medical Aid in Dying for the Terminally Ill

Act" became law in New Jersey. The new law allows mentally competent New Jersey residents with a terminal diagnosis and six months to live to request medication to end their lives.

New Jersey becomes the ninth state to allow assisted suicide, joining California, Colorado, Hawaii, Montana, Maine, Oregon, Vermont, Washington and District of Columbia.

Bishop James E. Checchio of Metuchen, New Jersey, Issued a statement renewing condemnation of assisted suicide, describing it as "a grievous affront to the dignity of human life" that "can never be morally justified."

"Passage of this law points to the utter failure of government, and indeed all society, to care truly, authentically and humanely for the suffering and vulnerable in our midst, especially those living with an incurable disease,...the ...elderly, the infirm and those ...with disabilities."

Checchio ...warned that assisted suicide was a particular threat to the elderly who could "feel ...pressure to view this as an option to prevent being a burden to others."

The bishop also warned that younger generations would come to [accept] the elderly, sick, and disabled killing themselves as normal. "With this law there will be a further desensitization of the value of human life," said Checchio.

Catholics "are called to show a different approach to death and the dying; one which accompanies every person as they are dying and allows them to love and to be loved to the very end."

"Let us strive to help the sick and incapacitated find meaning in their lives, even and especially in the midst of their suffering," said the bishop. "Let us, as a society and as individuals, choose to walk with them in their suffering, not contribute to eliminating the gift of life." (Full text at catholicnewsagency.com)
