

# Pastor's Message

My Dear Parish Family,

This weekend I would like to share some more reflections with you about the on-going crisis in our Diocese and Church. Daily we are flooded with information regarding our Bishops and Priests which minimally leave us wondering what is really going on and maximally lead us to doubt our Faith. What is really at the heart of our crisis? This is the question that I have been pondering for some time. I appeal to you out of love and know my reflections may be a challenge, especially in the face of the lies we have been fed for decades in our society.

I believe that the situation is no other than the force of evil, not only in our society but also within our Church. In the daily Mass readings offered this past Tuesday, St. Paul warns the Colossians to be on guard from false teachers, and instructed the Colossians to give praise and thanksgiving to God. I believe this warning is clearly also for us today. Taking Paul's warning along with the Book of Revelation, chapters 2 and 3, where we hear of the warnings for the seven churches, gives us great insight into our issues today. Paul warns against false teachers and the Book of Revelation offers correction to many of these seven churches that they have tolerated too much which is

contrary to the Gospel. It is important to mention that these churches were the hotbed of Christianity in the apostolic era but no longer exist today.

For many of us, in our lifetime, we have tolerated too much that is contrary to the Gospel. We have minimally tolerated, if not welcomed, false teachings into our lives. This has opened the door to allow evil to creep into our personal lives, society and even our church.

I was born in 1965. Although I was not personally aware at the time, in 1968, **Humanae Vitae**, an Encyclical Letter of His Holiness Paul VI on the regulation of birth, was published. It was controversial then, and still is today, as it calls Catholics to remember that marital relations were to always remain open to creating new life. Husband and wife are co-creators with God and cooperate in the gift of new life with God. Many rejected that teaching, then and now, and use artificial means to prohibit the transmission of life and limit the full, open experience of what God intended for us sexually. Honestly, this rejection of teaching opened the door to evil. (Continued on Page 2)

# (Pastor's Continued)

In 1973, Roe v. Wade opened the door to legalized abortion. This was expanded for a period under the Clinton presidency to include partial-birth abortion which was reversed under the Bush administration. In January 2019, New York State, under Governor Andrew Cuomo, passed the Reproductive Health Act which now allows for late-term abortions. It also "repealed a section of the public health law that required the following: that abortions after 12 weeks be performed in a hospital; that an additional physician be present for abortions after 20 weeks to care for "any live birth that is the result of the abortion"; and that such babies be provided "immediate legal protection under the laws of the state of New York." (www.factcheck.org) In the eyes of faith, the destruction of human life is evil and these laws have opened the door to evil. Also this year, on the other end of the life spectrum, The New York Medical Aid in Dying Act is under consideration in Assembly and Senate committees. This is another opening of the door to evil and removal of God as the author of life and definer of when life begins and ends.

Many of us have been fed lies. That along with the increased acceptance and available use of pornography and sexting and the changes in the biblical meaning of marriage have changed the landscape of our society from being rooted as "one nation under God" to being a nation of tolerance and full acceptance opposed to the Word of God.

If we take the above and add in the horror of the sexual abuse of minors in every facet of our society (family homes, public and private schools, athletics, Scouts and religious institutions, etc.) we see that we are confronting evil, pure and simple. We cannot pick and choose which evil we want to accept and tolerate versus those to be completely forbidden. It is really a "Pandora's Box" of evil which has been opened. I suggest to you that evil in all of its forms must be rejected as evil. The Word of God, upon which this nation was founded, must be restored as The Standard of truth, justice and "the good." Either we are rooted in God, or not.


What does it mean to be a "good Catholic?" Does a "good Catholic" pick and choose which parts of the Catechism and Sacred Scripture they agree with and support and which ones they reject ?Or does a "good Catholic" strive to agree with and support the total body of truth, even if it is difficult to live and unpopular?

As Catholics we do not accept abortion in any form, physician assisted suicide, the use of pornography or sexting, and we do not accept the sexual abuse of minors nor the sexual abuse of any person regardless of age. As a "good Catholic" I embrace the complete Catholic teaching as a beautiful way of life. I also suggest that as soon as we pick and choose which teachings we accept and reject, we ultimately land up in chaos. We are now in chaos. In the center of this chaos is evil. The chaos we are witnessing is not just an issue of the abuse crisis in our Church, but it is a compilation of all the issues affecting human life and sexuality. All of these issues and our tolerance of some, have allowed evil to be invited into our society and tolerated.

This is a time to overcome divisions which are deepening. This is a time to put down signs, leave picket lines and demonstrations. This is a time to join together in unified prayer before the Blessed Sacrament in our Adoration Chapel, a time to celebrate additional Masses, to pray the Rosary daily and to seek God's mercy and forgiveness for the sinful, life-destructive sins that have been committed not only in our Church but in our state, country and world. If we do not do this, I fear the rooting of evil will grow as will the pain, suffering and divisions we are experiencing. Please pray like you have never prayed before! This is not a time of despair, but a time to focus on the call to be Saints as we live the total Gospel of Jesus Christ.

May God bless you, our Mother Mary watch over you and St. Gregory the Great intercede for you, always.



Matthew 19:14 "Let the children come to me."

"Teach them to pray. The prayers of children are powerful. Ask your students to pray for their intentions, trusting that God will make something beautiful out of them. Whatever the problem, teach your students to ask God to work on it. They can learn the power of prayer and become motivated to pray for others. Ask them: Are you having a hard time forgiving? Ask God for his help. He can do *anything*. Do you know somebody who is sick, sad or scared about something? Pray for them. Is there a bully in school? Pray for them. Orient all of the students' cares to God and let them know you care. Teach them to use the rosary."


