Finally, I'd like to say a word about my upcoming sabbatical. I have been asked by parishioners, brother priests, family and friends: "Are you really going this time?" As you may recall, this is my third attempt to take a sabbatical.

My first attempt was in 2011 while I served at Our Lady of Pompeii. It was approved but cancelled due to discussions regarding Catholic Schools. Last year I was approved again to go, but cancelled because of the need to find a new Principal for St. Gregory the Great School. I am most grateful to Bishop Malone for giving me a third time at bat and this time I will not strike out!

My sabbatical is planned from July 1, 2018 to December 1, 2018. During this entire time I remain in fact the pastor of St. Gregory the Great Parish and return as Pastor to continue my term. most thankful to Father Tom Mahoney who will be the Administrator in my absence. I am especially grateful because Father Tom's three-year term at St. Greg's ends this June, 2018, and he generously volunteered to stay an additional year to allow me this opportunity. Thank you from the depth of my heart, Father Tom, for your goodness to me and to

the people of our St. Greg's family.

Many are asking me: "What are you going to be doing?" Here is a brief answer. The first week I intend to sleep and catch up on some needed rest. I will be attending a retreat for Priests in West Virginia on the Identity of the Priest as understood in the New Testament. This will be given by Dr. Scott Hahn from Franciscan University. I will attend a Scripture conference and an Apologetics conference at Franciscan University and also intend to take a couple courses from Franciscan in the fall term. Finally, I hope to complete writing a book and do some travel, most notably to Italy, and to spend some time in the Adirondack mountains and at the Trappist Monastery in Piffard, NY. While in Rome, I plan to celebrate Mass at St. Peter's Basilica and hopefully will be graced enough to preside at Mass above St. John Paul II's tomb. I am also thankful to Cardinal Dolan and to our Holy Father for inviting me to be elevated to the rank of Commander in the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem, Eastern Lieutenancy. The Knights of the Holy Sepulchre is a Roman Catholic Order of knighthood under the protection of the Holy See. The Pope is the sovereign of the Order which was established circa 1099. This will take me to New York City for an investiture at St. Patrick's Cathedral by Cardinal Dolan. If I accomplish all of this I will probably need a vacation from my sabbatical! I hope this answers the questions some of you may have. Please know I will be celebrating Mass daily and will be praying for you and our parish family every day.

May God bless you, our Mother Mary watch over you and St. Gregory the Great intercede for you, always.



Respect Life

Iowa Passes Fetal Heartbeat Bill: On May 4, Iowa Gov. Kim Reynolds signed into law the Fetal Heartbeat Bill, which prohibits doctors from performing an abortion after the detection of the baby's heartbeat.

The law would require any women seeking an abortion to undergo an ultrasound to determine whether a fetal heart-beat can be detected, a milestone usually detected around the sixth week of pregnancy. The legislation does make some exceptions for pregnancies conceived through rape or incest, as well as fetal abnormality, or if a doctor determines that a woman's life is in danger.

It would also ban all persons from knowingly acquiring, providing, transferring, or using fetal remains in Iowa. Previously, abortion was legal in Iowa until the 20th week of pregnancy. The new law is the strongest abortion regulation in the country.

"I believe that all innocent life is precious and sacred, and as governor, I pledged to do everything in my power to protect it," Gov. Reynolds said. The law will most certainly be challenged in court and is unlikely to go into effect without approval from the Supreme Court. Acknowledging this, Reynolds said that her actions...were "bigger than just a law," and that she will not be backing down.

Planned Parenthood and the ACLU promised a lawsuit. If this bill is taken to the Supreme Court, it could potentially force the justices to reconsider the 1973 Roe v. Wade decision that established a constitutional right to abortion.

Jeanne Mancini, president of March for Life, praised the law, saying it "will not only save lives, it also reminds us that abortion stops a beating heart." "We thank Iowa for recognizing that every life is a gift and that personhood has inherent dignity from the moment of conception," she said. (From catholicnewsagency.com)





Parenting Perspective

Pentecost refers to 50 days after Easter. It reminds us of fear, community, and bravery. The apostles were afraid after Jesus left them. They gathered together. The Spirit filled them with courage to speak out. Ask your family what helps them be brave? Can anyone identify a recent courageous act?
