From the desk of Store/ Café

In the spring of 2012 two new Ministries began here at St. Gregory's. The old rectory and garage that connected to the Ministry Center were transformed into our Café and Catholic Store. The planning and renovation took approximately 2 years to get everything up and running. The Store opened its doors in April 2012 and the Café followed in June. They both continue to operate, thanks to the support of Fr. Leon, our Parish, and the community. The Catholic Store and Café are both open six days a week and Wednesday evenings. Check the Bulletin or website for our hours.

From the Store:

For our relatively small space, the Store carries a huge variety of items for all occasions, and general items to keep our faith growing. To help people grow in their personal faith we carry a large selection of inspirational books, novena books, Bibles, catechisms, and even books to explain each if you are unsure about how to use these materials. The Store has merchandise that would help people to express their Faith to others and be a sign of their Catholic lifestyle. We have Crucifixes, holy pictures, and framed artwork, to hang in your homes or give as gifts. In addition you can buy holy water fonts – many of us grew up seeing these in our homes, and never left or entered the house without blessing ourselves with holy water. We carry various Medals, Scapulars, Rosary bracelets, and fashion jewelry made by a designer from Texas in unique designs with heirloom holy Medals. If you are in need of a Rosary you'll find one here! We carry Rosaries in crystal, silver, wood, children's, along with chaplets and finger Rosaries, in a wide range of prices.

Celebrating special Sacraments such as Baptism, First Communion, or Confirmation? Let us help you choose the perfect sacramental gifts, cards and even gift bags. We carry greeting cards for all occasions. Our children's corner is stocked with books for all ages, stuffed animals that recite prayers, small games and DVDs, all with the purpose to help them learn more about, and grow in, their Faith.

Christmas will be here soon and we stock many items to help us all keep Christ in our Christmas. Religious boxed cards, Advent wreaths and candles, ornaments, decorations, Manger sets, gifts for all your loved ones that will help them remember what this season is all about. Even outside statues for when spring comes again!

We are blessed to have this Catholic Store here at our Parish, and your support is invaluable. I would be remiss not to mention the hours put in by our Volunteers who do so much to keep the store going. Most of our volunteers have been here since our opening and are dedicated and committed to this Ministry: without them we would not succeed. I am so thankful for the treasure of their time! Whether you are a 'regular' here at the Store or an occasional shopper – thank you! If you have never been here, take some time to stop in: the cozy charm of the Store will leave you lingering and browsing with ease, and you never know what treasures you may find!

From the Café:

"For he satisfies the thirsty and fills the hungry with good things" Psalm 107.9 What is the most sacred time of the day for your family? Meal time. Our family meal is the only thing we take in with our senses that actually becomes a part of us. Pretty simple, but pretty profound. In fact, it's what our whole Catholic Faith is founded upon. The Eucharist is the meal we share as Catholics where God Himself becomes a part of us and we a part of Him. The sacredness of the family/friend meal is the inspiration behind the St Gregory the Great Café.

The original Café manager, Shelly Femia, was instrumental in creating a warm, inviting atmosphere for the Café. From the cozy couches to the decorative touches everywhere, the Café is truly a place to visit. The initial and continuing objective of this Ministry is to invite everyone from the parish and entire community to gather and visit with friends after dropping kids off at school, after Mass, or anytime for breakfast or lunch. We have small groups that stop in on a weekly basis now and sometimes stay for hours! For example, a group of Canisius High School alum from the Southtowns to the Northtowns began coming to plan their 50th reunion, and now meet here weekly. Families and children are welcome. We have a children's corner with toys and books to keep them busy while parents relax with coffee.

The menu is always changing and expanding. Breakfast sandwiches are made-to-order and served all day. There are a variety of pastries with many of them being baked right on premises in the ministry kitchen. For lunch we offer soup, mouth-watering paninis, salads and desserts. During the summer we are grilling hot dogs, hamburgers and Italian sausage served on our outdoor patio, and during Lent we serve a variety of pierogis. Every Wednesday night is pizza night at the Café. We have amazing volunteer pizza chefs creating specialty pizzas made to order. During the holidays we feature visits from Santa and the Easter Bunny.

Our volunteers have generous and hospitable hearts. Many of them have commented that people and forming meeting friendships through this Ministry has been a blessing in their life. So come with a friend, or come alone. You're always welcome, and we're happy to see you!




